Check Metadata

Once you've gone through all of the sections listed above, you may be ready to submit your metadata. You'll notice a colored circle next to **Check Metadata** on the right. **Red** means that you have an error, most often being a missing section that is required to be filled out. Orange-Yellow means you only have warnings, usually a recommendation to add or improve upon your metadata. Green means there are neither any errors or warnings and that your metadata is ready to be submitted. You may submit your metadata with warnings. However, you should review each warning before submission.

Submit Metadata

After clicking on the **Submit Metadata** text, a window will appear displaying the name of the Image File and its XML File. The Submit Metadata button creates a zip of these two files, named with the Document Name – not the Image name, and submits the zip to MOTHER.

NOTE: In order to submit, there must be an image file loaded and the metadata must not contain any errors. If these conditions are not met, then the Submit Metadata button is disabled.
