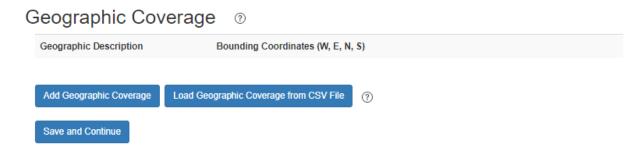
Geographic/Temporal Coverage

Geographic and Temporal Coverage is optional. However, for some images this may be an important component of your metadata. For example, if the donors were retrieved at a particular geographic location on a specific date, this can be captured as part of the metadata.

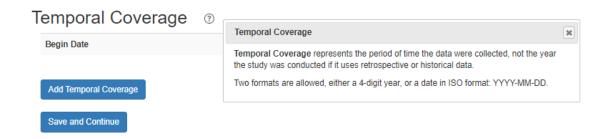
If you know the general geographic location where the donor was found, you can provide the bounding coordinates as latitude and longitude values. All coordinates are typed as decimals. Use latitude as the North and South bounding coordinate, and longitude as the West and East bounding coordinate. East should be greater than or equal to West and North should be greater than or equal to South. Since all four elements are required, a bounding area that is a single point should use the same latitude values for North Bounding Coordinate and South Bounding Coordinate, and the same longitude for West Bounding Coordinate and East Bounding Coordinate.
